This is with reference to the proposal submitted by Sir Vithaladas Tackkersey College of Home Science, SNDT Women's University, Juhu Tara Road, Santacruz (W), Mumbai-400 049 (MS) affiliated to SNDT Women's University for extension of autonomous status under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

On the basis of the report of the UGC Expert Committee and on the basis of the recommendations of the Standing Committee, the Commission at its meeting held on 29.09.2017 has decided to grant extension of autonomous status to Sir Vithaladas Tackkersey College of Home Science, SNDT Women's University, Juhu Tara Road, Santacruz (W), Mumbai-400 049 (MS) for a period w.e.f. 2017-2018 to 2021-2022.

SNDT Women's University, 1, Nathibai Thackersey Road, Mumbai-400 020 may issue necessary notification/order regarding the grant of extension of autonomous status to the college as per the UGC Guidelines for Autonomous Colleges. The college, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per the norms laid down in the Guidelines.

The autonomous college shall be guided by the provisions of the UGC Guidelines for Autonomous Colleges. The Guidelines are available on the UGC website, www.ugc.ac.in. However, the college may take special note of the following:

(a) The college will constitute the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) under intimation to UGC. The Cell will have an external Peer Team comprising of academicians of repute and will send report to UGC regarding the performance of the college. The report will also be put on public domain on the website of the College. The external peer review shall be conducted atleast once in a year.
