Direct Admissions for Standard XI (Home Science)

Sir Vithaldas Thackersey College of Home Science (Autonomous) is a constituent college of S.N.D.T. Women's University, Mumbai. It has a **Government aided Junior College only for girls**. We charge **Nominal fees** as per the Government norms.

The College has been providing direct offline admissions in **Junior College for Home Science stream**. This academic year (2020-2021), due to the current pandemic situation, **online** procedure will be followed for the **admissions**. Student who have Science subject in SSC examination may apply for admission.

The College belongs to **Maharashtra State Board** and follows the board **syllabus and examination** for Standard XI and XII. The subjects offered are English, Hindi / Marathi, Psychology, Sociology, Chemistry and Biology.

Essential Documents to be uploaded:

- Signature of Parent / Guardian

Please upload scanned copies in PDF format.

- Standard 10th / SSC Mark sheet (It is **mandatory** for all candidates).
- School Leaving certificate
- Aadhar Card
- Declaration with regards to fee concession (in given format)
- Proof of residence in Maharashtra state: Ration card (first and last page) - It should indicate date of residing in the state of Maharashtra for more than 15 years. **OR** Domicile certificate
- Undertaking* regarding Provisional admission (in given format)

Additional Documents for students from other than Maharashtra State Board:

Please upload with your application scanned copies in PDF format of the following documents.

- Migration / Transfer certificate
- Passing certificate

Please note, after admission the student has to submit the following. The Admission Committee will facilitate the acquisition of 'Deed of Undertaking and Eligibility form' (available with Maharashtra state board).

If any of the above mentioned documents are not available, then one should mention it in the Undertaking* for the same and can submit the document/s later. Till then the admissions remains provisional.

- Student must have cleared Science subject in SSC examination with minimum of 35 marks.
- Admissions are open for ATKT students also.

Eligibility for Concessional Fee as per the Government Norms

➤ **Eligible Candidate – Fee amount Rs. 1195/-**

One who has provided the required documents to prove her eligibility.

- (1) A proof of residence (Ration Card / Domicile Certificate) that she is staying Maharashtra for 15 Years or more
- (2) Deed of Undertaking that she is not 4th / 5th or higher number child of her parent

➤ **Non Eligible candidate – Fee amount Rs. 1555/-**

- (a) One who has not provided the required documents to prove her eligibility.
- (b) A student who has stayed in Maharashtra for less than 15 years.
- (c) A student who is 4th / 5th or higher number child of her parent
