As per the UGC guidelines, Government circular and SNDTWU, Mumbai circular the College reopened from 15th February 2021.

Second Term: Academic Year 2020-2021

- First term break is from 4th March 2021 to 14th March 201.

- All theory and Practical classes will be conducted online.
- The second term will remain virtual till the College receives clear guidelines from the State Government of Maharashtra and S.N.D.T.Women's University, Mumbai.

Note:

All students are requested to check the College website regularly for any update based on guidelines issued by the Government and SNDTWU, Mumbai.

University Hostel:

Till date, there is no communication from the University regarding the reopening of the hostel. All out-station students should find alternative accommodation in Mumbai so that they can attend practical classes in the College. Please note that these classes will not be conducted online.

COVID-19 safe campus:

- The College had appointed Professional Experts to clean and sanitize the entire premise.
- The College staff is trained about thorough cleaning and sanitizing procedures which are followed every day.
- Infra-red thermometer is used for thermal check of each person entering the College.
- Sanitizer dispensers are available at several places in the College premise.
- Hand wash liquid and tissue paper rolls are provided in all the toilet blocks.



Our responsibilities:

The following public health measures are to be followed to reduce the risk of COVID-19 by all in these places at all times: *(Reference: UGC Guidelines D.O. 14-8/2020(CPP-II) dated 5th November 2020)*

- i. Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as feasible
- ii. Proper use of face covers/masks while on campus
- iii. Frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty
Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds) wherever feasible
Please carry a small bottle of sanitizer to keep yourself safe while commuting / travelling to and from College.
- iv. Strict adherence to Respiratory etiquettes
This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing / sneezing with a tissue / handkerchief / flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues properly.
- v. Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest
- vi. Spitting strictly prohibited
- vii. Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App wherever feasible
