**Notice for Off-line Classes in the Academic Year 2021-2022
Self-Financed Programs**

Please note the following with regards to the commencement of offline classes from next semester scheduled to begin from January 2022.

- 1) From 3rd January 2022, the second term of the academic year 2021-2022 is scheduled to begin and most of the classes will be conducted offline (in campus)
- 2) Only those students who are fully vaccinated will be allowed to attend the off-line classes.
- 3) Few classes will continue to be conducted online, so students who come to the campus for off-line classes will be required to attend online classes using their own devices while on the campus or on their way.
- 4) The Final examination of semester I, and III will continue to be conducted online in December 2021. The detailed schedule will be uploaded shortly.
- 5) The students who are fully vaccinated will be allowed to come to the campus for attending classes as per the timetable.

Hostel accommodation

Hostel accommodation is provided by the S.N.D.T. Women's University at Juhu campus and Churchgate campus. However, till date, there is no circular from the University regarding Hostel Admission.

- a) The University Juhu hostel has been closed since March 2020 and it is likely that the hostel will only be reopened in a phase wise manner i.e. only a few rooms would be allotted in each phase.
- b) The hostel is managed by the University and limited seats are offered to SVT College. These seats are for the students of the aided program only.
- c) The post graduate students of unaided self-financed programs are therefore informed to arrange for alternate private hostel or paying guest accommodations for their stay in the city. The local classmates are encouraged to help out station students to find such facilities.
