Report and Analysis of Student's Feedback of Curriculum 2021-2022

Feedback was collectively obtained from the students as stakeholders from all the Specializations of the Sir Vithaldas Thackersey College of Home Science (Autonomous). An online questionnaire was administered via the MIS system. It covered all the questions with respect to all the components of curriculum development and outcomes. The respondents were expected to rate the components based on a three-point Likert scale ranging from Strongly agree, Agree and Disagree. A total of 410 responses obtained were collected from various departments and analysed accordingly. The findings were as follows:
