The Institute makes consistent efforts to upgrade and maintain the academic infrastructure (Classrooms, laboratory and library)	Nearly 13.26% students were having an opinion to upgrade and maintain the academic infrastructure.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have enhanced wifi support in each of the classrooms. • Implemented LMS which students can access to consume the resources • New learning resources were made available in the library
ICT facilities (laboratories, classrooms, library) and wi-fi facilities in BYOD zones are available 24 X 7 in the Institute	Nearly 19.12% students felt that ICT facilities need improvement.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Special technology orientation was conducted for the newly admitted students in 2024-25. They were given a walkthrough of what things are available, how to use it, whom to approach. • Hardware for each of the computers in the computer lab are upgraded • Technical support is immediately made available for trouble shooting in use of ICT • Students are provided with laptops on a need basis for field work.
