Rules for Entrance Examination

The students who are eligible to appear for the entrance examination for admission to MSc Developmental Counselling and Mental Wellbeing are hereby notified that the entrance examination is **scheduled on 22nd June 2026.**

The details of the format, marks distribution and schedule of examination are provided below:

1. Total marks- 50
2. Exam Duration - 1 hours
3. Mode of examination- On campus (offline) at Sir Vithaldas Thackersey College of Home Science (Empowered Autonomous), SNDT Women's University, Mumbai Room No. 119.
4. Format: objective and subjective-
 - a) **Part A** - 30 marks- Objective questions.
 - b) **Part B** - 20 marks - Subjective questions

- 5) The list of students eligible for entrance exam and online interviews will be displayed on the college website on 20th June 2026.
- 6) The interviews will be conducted offline in college post entrance exams on 24th June 2026 from 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm as per the schedule. All applicants eligible for entrance exam will be eligible to appear for interviews.
- 7) Admission offer will be given as per eligibility criteria, and academic merit (based on marks obtained in undergraduate courses, entrance examination, and personal interview). **The first merit list will be displayed tentatively on 27th June 2026.**
- 8) The admission offers provided to the students will be provisional until they have submitted their sixth-semester mark sheet. The college can cancel the admission if the selected student does not clear courses in the sixth semester.

Important Points to Note

1. Students must report at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time for the entrance exam. Any student who has not taken her seat 10 minutes before the start time will not be allowed to appear for the exam.
2. **Students are required to carry photo identity proof and college ID cards. The stationary items must be in a transparent pouch.**
3. No bags, mobile phones, lunch boxes will be allowed inside the exam rooms.
